The Swiss Centre of Expertise in Life Course Research LIVES has developed an interactive glossary containing more than 30 concepts. It shares a common language with the whole scientific community for the study of vulnerability in a life-course perspective.

This wiki is intended to help junior and advanced researchers by providing an overview of central concepts such as vulnerability, trajectories, reserves, cumulative (dis)advantages, resilience, longitudinal data (retrospective and prospective) and many others.
